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## MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

### Attendance

The regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the Westglenn Metropolitan District was called and held as shown above in accordance with the statutes of the State of Colorado. The following Directors, having confirmed their qualifications to serve on the Board, were in attendance:

Also present were Elizabeth A. Dauer, Esq., Seter & Vander Wall, P.C.; Kay Hamel, District Accountant; and Richard Hamel, District Maintenance Supervisor.

### Call to Order

Director Sullivan convened the special meeting at 11:01 a.m., noting that a quorum of the Board was present and had confirmed their continuing qualification to serve as Directors.

### Disclosure Matters

The Board had been previously advised that pursuant to Colorado law, certain disclosures by the Board members might be required prior to taking official action at the meeting. The Board then reviewed the agenda for the meeting, following which each Board member confirmed the contents of written disclosures previously made, stating the fact and summary nature of any matters, as required under Colorado law, to permit official action to be taken at the meeting. The Directors specifically noted that they are members of a limited liability company that purchased additional ground located in the District on September 30, 1999, in an arms-length transaction. The Board determined that the participation of the members present was necessary to obtain a quorum or otherwise enable the Board to act.

Director Seeley reported he had disclosed his interest as an owner of property located within the District, and his association with Brookhill VII, LLC, developers in the District.

Upon motion made, seconded and unanimously carried, the minutes of the August 17, 2021 special meeting were approved as presented.

## Financial Matters / Payment of Claims

Ms. Hamel presented the District's financial reports for the period ending August 31, 2021. Director Sullivan inquired of Ms. Hamel who confirmed that all accounting continues to be maintained according to GAAP, there were no unusual transactions during the time period, there were no transactions involving the directors; and, the District remains capable of paying its obligations through 2021. Upon motion made by Director Sullivan, the financial report was accepted as presented.

## Dog Park Project

Ms. Dauer reported that a meeting with Westminster representatives, Director Seeley, and Dennis B. Polk, Esq. has been scheduled for September 28, 2021 to discuss the dog park matter.

## Park Update/ Maintenance Status Report

Mr. Hamel stated that the park looks good. He noted that drilling continues for the electric main and the tree company has completed grinding down the stumps of the dead trees. He noted that replacement trees are scheduled to be planted soon. Mr. Hamel also reported that the third Westglenn apartment building is now open.

The directors discussed availability to attend the October meeting and determined that that meeting date needed to be changed.
